We offer both 2- and 4-week medical student rotations from August through December of each academic year. Please apply early, as the schedule can fill up.

To help us better understand your learning needs, we request that you submit the following to [schcresidency@shastahealth.org](mailto:schcresidency@shastahealth.org):

1. Dean's Letter of Good Standing
2. Unofficial Medical School Transcript
3. Unofficial USMLE or COMLEX Scores
4. Personal statement about your goals and interests in medicine. *Please describe why you would like to specifically rotate at SCHC.*

We have affiliation agreements with many medical schools, so please check with our staff (through the above email address) to determine if this needs to be established with your school.

If you can submit the above information, along with your requested dates, we will review and contact you regarding a potential rotation. We typically decide on our final medical student rotation schedule in late April or early May. After review of your application and if approved, we will ask that you give us the contact information for the student affairs office of your institution so we can begin the process of developing an affiliation agreement if needed.
